To Mayor and Village Board.....from Sue Anne Vogelsberg 242 Prospect Road

- 1.) Thank you recent robocall re: leaves. With winter approaching, please send out the routine robo reminder re: safety measures for snow plows, etc.
- 2.) NYS Comptroller has been notified of approval of Village Procurement policy on 9-30-2020 and concerns re: selection of "Reliable Computers" located at 2 Roanoke (nearly equidistant from the homes of both "volunteers" Joel Stern and Issac Ekstein) and the newly budgeted \$40,000.00 for a Village vehicle.
- 3.) Budgeted Village Attorney fees (A1420) have increased to \$131,500 annually. With Village Attorney routinely attending various 'non-traditional' meetings these past 2 months, am concerned that over the coming year, the Village will billed for any additional hours not covered in the 2020-2021 budget.
- 4.) NYS AG Public Integrity Bureau has been notified, ie complaint filed, on 11-16-2020, re: continued use of "volunteer positions" for both Joel Stern and Issac Ekstein--despite receiving correspondence from Orange County Human Resources Steven Gross on 10-22-2020 and again on 11-13-2020 against this unauthorized practice. Both News12 and Times Herald Record have been notified as well.
- 5.) F/U to former Mayor LoFranco at 11-09-2020 Village Board meeting  
I too was approached by Joel Stern.. On Sunday 3-8-2020 at approx 3:30 PM while campaigning on Holland Court, Stern approached me as he was taking his garbage cans to the curb. Told me he would get me elected as a 'write-in' candidate for Mayor (election on 3-18-2020) and he even had 2 female Trustee candidates to run with me--one of which is not a Village resident, thereby NOT eligible to even be a candidate! Stern ignored my comment.  
As per our-LoFranco/Vogelsberg Counsel's request (Counsel was obtained due to lawsuit alleging fraud in obtaining candidate petitions--a lawsuit which we won BTW)I obtained all absentee ballot requests dated as of 3-10-2020 (election 3-18-2020). Of the 150 submitted requests, only 8 used the Village specific form as NYS Village elections are conducted by the Village Clerk. The remaining 142 requests utilized the generic NYS absentee ballot request form, many of which were pre-printed with the resident's address already on the form, only needing the resident's signature to be added. These 142 requests all documented that either Joel Stern or Issac Ekstein would be picking up the ballot for said resident. I submitted this and my other election concerns to both Orange County and NYS Board of Elections at that time.

Recently, it was brought to my attention that the election lawsuit brought against both myself and former Mayor LoFranco was personally financed by Joel Stern as per Stern's acknowledgement.

Mr Mayor in a Facebook post it states, through the efforts of yourself and attorney Ugell the ongoing litigation regarding the bus has been dropped. What efforts took place? The Village won the initial lawsuit and we were now being Counter sued. So, your effort was a phone call to the attorney for the village stating we will allow the bus to operate again and the bus company dropped the counter lawsuit, no great effort from what I see. The post also stated this relieves the village from major liability and potential financial loss. The counter lawsuit defense was being paid by the insurance company for the village. So, I don't understand what was meant by that. Is there a schedule for the bus, I'm sure the residents would like to take advantage of this service.

I am concerned with school buses being parked on the Kiefer property located on Museum Village rd and State route 208. I'm pretty sure that according to village code you cannot just decide to use a property as a parking lot especially for buses. This is considered an unlisted use and would need approval from the Village board. Was any approval given? This location is busy and dangerous without buses going in and out. This is a major safety issue. I also believe NYS DOT would have to give approval.
