Description of the Clovewood Project: The Project consists of a residential development of what the Project Sponsor described as 600 single family lots, within a site of approximately 708.2 acres located at the Project Site. The Project Site is generally vacant land, except for the abandoned former Lake Anne Country Club buildings which would be demolished as part of the Project. 702 acres of the Project Site are claimed by the Project Sponsor to be within the Village's RR Zoning District and approximately 6.2 acres is claimed by the Project Sponsor to be in the RC-I Zoning District. The Project Site would be developed. The Project would also include associated infrastructure, including but not limited to roads, utilities, on-site water supply, sewage treatment plant, stormwater and erosion control systems, and community recreational facilities.
